What happens at camp?

The purpose of camp is to have a safe and welcoming environment for middle school students to discover and grow in their faith. We desire to give students opportunities to open the Bible, talk about faith, and to hear some impactful messages that relate to them. We always share the good news about Jesus Christ but also leave lots of room for questions that students may have.

We also know middle schoolers love fun! We want church to be a place where they have fun with their community, want to invite friends and know they are safe.

Who goes to camp?

This camp is for students who are entering 6th grade through 8th grade students. At camp we take adult leaders who have been background checked, have a vital relationship with Jesus and have been consistent within our church.

How do students travel at camp?

We are taking a bus this year for our transportation to Wild Rivers. We hire a professional company to drive us to and from Wild Rivers.

Location of Camp:

BaseCamp Jolt will be taking place at The Rock. This is the youth building of Mount of Olives Church. It is located across the street from the main campus.

The address is: 24851 Chrisanta Dr. Mission Viejo.

Friday night students will be sleeping at The Rock. Boys and Girls will be sleeping in separate rooms. Leaders will be in the same room but separated from students and never permitted to share sleeping spaces. We also have visible cameras throughout the interior and exterior of the building monitoring.

We will be at Wild Rivers Saturday. Students will not have phones but we will have a designated bungalow reserved for our group that will be our meeting place. We will also keep students in groups of three or more, and leaders.

Our ticketed price for Wild Rivers will include lunch for students.

How much does camp cost?

We ask for \$150 donation for this camp. This pays for activities, meals, Wild Rivers Tickets, transportation, and supplies.
