Who goes to camp?

This camp is for students who are entering 9th grade through 12th grade students. At camp we take adult leaders who have been background checked, have a vital relationship with Jesus and have been consistent within our church.

We also bring a licensed nurse/medic with us in case of any emergency big or small. If we do have an emergency with a student, parents will be notified as soon as possible. Our nurse also comes to disperse student medications. We ask all students to bring their meds in original bottles with their name on it. These will be given to our medic at camp check in.

How do students get to camp?

We are excited to be taking a charter bus this year for our transportation to Zion retreat. We hire a professional company to drive us to and from camp and any excursions off site. We will also be taking a mini van for any local needs.

Location of Camp:

We will be staying in a town just north of Zion National Park called Beaver, Utah. We stay in a home that sleeps over 60 people and is on its own private land. Males and Females do not share rooms or bathrooms.

How much does camp cost?

We ask for \$600 donation for this camp. This pays for lodging, transportation, activities, food and supplies.
